DOES YOUR CHILD HAVE ADHD?

UB's Center for Children and Families is running a study for fathers of children with ADHD aged 6-12. The goal of the study is to determine whether a parenting program for fathers helps improve the functioning of children with ADHD.

If your child qualifies, your family will be assigned to receive additional psychological treatment or to continue with the treatment and parenting strategies you are currently using. Psychological treatment includes parenting programs for the fathers and participation in structured soccer activities for the child.

There is no fee for participating in this study. All psychological treatments will be provided free of charge.
