

## PARENTS:

Do you have a child ages 7-11 with **ADHD** who has problems with

## **AGGRESSION, MOOD SWINGS or DEPRESSION?**

While most ADHD treatments are not designed to help these issues, UB's Center for Children and Families is studying a new therapy program to treat ADHD and mood problems. The study will also evaluate if ADHD medicines like Ritalin and Adderall improve these other mood problems.



Eligible families will receive medication for their child's ADHD by doctors who are experts in ADHD. Families may also be offered the chance to participate in the new therapy program to help both ADHD and mood problems.

The 12 session group therapy program is designed to help parents manage ADHD, anger outbursts and other mood problems at home while teaching children how to recognize their moods, control anger and get along better with other children.
