UB's Center for Children and Families is looking for **ADHD Children between the ages of 5-12**, who show signs of behavioral difficulties to participate in a one-year study. The goal of the study is to determine whether children with ADHD should be treated with medication, behavior therapy or both, and in what order these treatments should be given.

If your child qualifies, your family will be assigned to receive psychological treatment, medication treatment, or both during the upcoming school year. Psychological treatment includes parent training, school consultation, and possible social skills training, tutoring and attendance at an academic and recreational Saturday program. A physician specialist will treat children who receive medication.

There is no fee for participating in this study. All psychological and medication treatments will be provided free of charge.
